Chairman Mehlberg called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

Moved by Seefeldt and seconded by Sass to approve the following agenda with the additions of C. 2. Elevator Delegation and C. 3. Math curriculum presentation by Tammy Sprouse.

The school board heard delegations from Bob Bjerke; He presented to the board that the board should consider what the community and volunteers have invested into the track and what he sees for the future of the track. Selling the land would interfere with throwing areas and practice fields. A track would help in showcasing the school and grounds. Jeff Olsen and Wayne Schlagel presented that the land is needed for building purposes and the need for their business to prosper.
